## Mission of the Month: CHATTABOX

Chattabox Holiday Club will be taking place from the 14th-18th August. Each morning around 100 primary school age children will gather at Oundle C.E. Primary School for a lively time of fun together. This year they will be exploring the story of Joseph from the Old Testament, under the theme of 'Pyramid Rock!'. There will be crafts, games, dramas, discussions, worship and more. All the morning sessions are led by an amazing team of 70 teenagers and young adults who work their socks off to help the children encounter God and build relationships with each other.

The team of young people camp on site for the whole week and in the afternoons and evenings each day they have their own programme of activities and teaching. Chattabox presents the churches in Oundle with an amazing opportunity each year to share the Christian faith with children and young people, and to allow these young leaders to use their gifts and talents in God's service, modelling to their peers what it looks like to be a disciple of Jesus.
