The total raised in the Oundle area in **Christian Aid Week** , largely from the house-to-house collections, was £6,302.82. With gift-aid, this will amount to £7,059.64. This is about £1,400 less than last year, mainly because some villages were unable to organise collections this year. Very many thanks to all organisers and collectors, and to those who donated. The money will be used to help provide support and shelter to displaced people in countries such as Haiti. (*News flash:* Marcelin and his three daughters in Haiti, who had lost their home after a hurricane and were featured in this year's appeal, have now been rehoused thanks to Christian Aid's partner organisation there.)
